MEDICAL RELEASE AND MEDICATION POLICY OF FERRWOOD MUSIC CAMP:

ALL medication (even over the counter meds) must be given to staff at Sunday registration. Students are not allowed to self-administer. Meds are not allowed in the dorms unless cleared with the director. **Students who take any medication into the dorms will be excluded from camp.** Inhalers, insulin pumps and epi pens (with directors knowledge) and with parent written permission for the student to carry are the only exceptions. Prescription meds MUST be in the original bottle with the doctor's name and camper's name clearly printed on the outside of the bottle.

- If a medical emergency occurred, or a life threatening event was to happen, a 911 call will be placed immediately. Parents would be notified simultaneously. Valley Regional Fire and Rescue services Butler Township. EMS law states the medic dispatched to the scene has the final say as to which hospital the person is taken to; if transportation to a hospital is required. In the event of such an emergency, parents do not have a choice of hospital. Failure to give consent to this policy would have to exclude your son / daughter from camp.

- All medications are administered by adult counselor staff or the camp director or a nurse (7 am – 9 am and 7 pm – 9 pm). Students and staff will sign, on a daily basis, to verify the medication was administered. Parents are welcome to administer medication to their child should they desire.
