RULES AND REGULATIONS

*The Ferrwood Music Camp Rules and Regulations are designed to ensure that all campers have a fun, yet safe experience. It is important that all participants abide by the rules; therefore, we ask that parents and campers familiarize themselves with this information. **Parents and Campers must sign and return this document at check-in!***

Camp participants must follow the rules at all times. This includes periods when not on Ferrwood property, i.e. off-site activities.

1. Participants are restricted to the grounds of Ferrwood Music Camp (FMC) unless written permission is received authorizing the child to leave the premises. Permission slip can be obtained at camp or online. Documents can also be obtained by calling 570 436 4504. **Any child under the age of 18, leaving camp, for any reason, without written permission from their parents, will be expelled from camp with no refund.**
2. Campers are not permitted in any wooded area surrounding the camp. Please be warned that there is a substantial amount of Poison Ivy growing in these areas.
3. Campers are not to leave the gated area at any time, unless with a group attending an authorized function .
4. Students are expected to be polite and respectful. Demonstrating respect for others property is also expected. Under no circumstances should you enter into or borrow another person's belongings. This will be cause for dismissal. Personal space must be respected at all times.
5. Any behavior suggesting intimacy is not permitted. This includes hand holding, lying against one another, or hugging. Boys and girls are not permitted to socialize in each other's dorms. The only time a *person* is permitted in a dorm of the opposite gender is when they are being used as a classroom for music instruction. Campers may not enter the dorm of the opposite gender at any other time, for any reason. This would cause immediate dismissal without a refund.
6. Fighting, intimidating, harassing, bullying, foul language, indecent behavior, stealing, tampering with or destruction of property will result in immediate dismissal from camp without a refund.
7. Possession and/or use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or other illegal substances, items, or devices are strictly prohibited. This will this result in immediate dismissal and prosecution under the law.
8. Dress code: Leisure, fun clothes are appropriate; *however*, modesty must prevail and any clothing considered provocative or offensive is prohibited. T-shirts suggestive of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or sexual inferences will not be allowed. Unless swimming, boys must wear shirts at all times. Anyone participating on a hike **MUST** wear sneakers!
9. All students are expected to arrive on time and remain for entire music class.
10. Good personal hygiene is mandatory. If *camp* staff determines that a *camper* is not showering or is demonstrating poor hygiene they will be asked to shower immediately. If a camper refuses, he or she will be asked to leave camp.
11. All campers must be inside and remain inside the dorm by 10:00 p.m. Lights out will be at 10:30 p.m.
12. Campers are responsible for returning recreation equipment to its proper place.
At no time is food or drink allowed in the dorms. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** All snacks must be stored in

the kitchen storage area.

- 13. During lesson time students are permitted to drink water. Food is not allowed.
- 14. Everyone must attend all meals. Snacks and soda will be permitted after lunch. Personal snacks may also be accessed at this time. No soda, candy, or snacks after 8 pm or one hour before supper.
- 15. Littering is not permitted. Soda and snack privileges may be suspended for the entire camp.
- 16. The reception room is off limits between 8:30 and 9:00 a.m. Campers are allowed in the reception room as long as there is an adult chaperone.
- 18. No running on the porch.

The camp administration reserves final judgment on any behavior.

Please do not sign this paper until Sunday / Monday check-in. Parents and campers must sign and return this document at Sunday check-in. This must be signed at camp.

I have read the rules and understand my responsibility. I understand if I am asked to leave camp for breaking a rule, no refunds will be given.
